

Module title: Advances in Radiotherapy & Oncology Management
Module code: 7HSK0365

This is a 15 credit, level 7, distance learning module that can be studied on its own or as a module on the following educational pathways:

- MSc / Pg. Dip Advanced RT and Oncology Practice
- MSc Advanced Practice
- Postgraduate Certificate in Radiotherapy Clinical Specialist

This module runs in Semester A commencing October 3rd 2022.

Course aim

The aim of the course is to enable you to critically reflect on contemporary issues and technological advances within therapeutic radiography practice and to evaluate the role of radiotherapy and adjuvant therapies in the management of a range of cancers.

Content

Content of the module facilitates advancement of your knowledge and understanding of holistic oncological management care and the technical advances underpinning contemporary radiotherapy practice. Using an inquiry-based approach, you will gather and explore a wide range of evidence related to topics such as advanced radiotherapy techniques and equipment, cancer management and personalised holistic patient care. You will be encouraged to draw on aspects of your own experiences and discuss them within the context of best practice frameworks and guidelines to further your personal and professional knowledge.

Assessment

100% coursework, submitted on-line. Typically, a written piece equivalent to 3000 words.

This is a distance-learning module that employs a variety of electronic resources and tasks, and virtual classroom sessions to support your learning. You are supported to become independent learners through contact with the module leader who guides you through your learner journey.
