Please note that the documents must be in your **CURRENT NAME**, as this will be used for your DBS; please also provide any documents that show if you have changed your name, ie Change of Name Deed, Adoption/Marriage Certificate.

AT LEAST ONE DOCUMENT MUST ALSO SHOW YOUR CURRENT ADDRESS

You may also need to have your fingerprints taken by the local Police if you are not able to provide sufficient proof of ID – you will be advised if this is needed
