Important points

- The programmes include a combination of research modules (60 credits), core and optional modules.
- To attain a Master's award requires 180 credits. Interim awards of Postgraduate Certificate (60 credits) and Postgraduate Diploma (120 credits) are available.
- The programmes are offered in part-time mode (up to 6 years).
- The expectation is that you will attend all of your taught sessions.
- Where appropriate for some modules, you will need to meet specific pre-requisites.
- The (HHPSCCPGC) Post Graduate Certificate in Patient Assessment and Management (CCP) is 60 credits which are all the core CCP modules for the pathway. This is a 9-month programme, which must be completed within one academic year.
- The MSc Advanced Paramedic Practice (Critical Care) is 180 credits, including at least 150 at Level 7 with 60 credits from the core CCP modules with no more than 30 credits below Level 7.
- Applicants to the programme must be registered with the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC) as a Paramedic and must maintain registration for the duration of the programme.
- Entry is normally at BSc level (or equivalent). If you do not have a first degree or equivalent, you will be expected to evidence successful completion of at least 30 credits of Level 6 study.

Academic Year

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For most postgraduate students the academic year is split into two Semesters (A & B). Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C)

- Semester A runs from Monday 17 September 2018 to Friday 11 January 2019
- Semester B runs from Monday 14 January 2019 to Friday 17 May 2019
- Semester C runs from Monday 20 May 2019 to Friday 13 September 2019
