

Module title: Radiotherapy Breast Localisation**Module code: 7HSK0233**

This is a 15-credit, level 7, work-based learning module for therapeutic radiographers that can be studied on its own or as a module on the following educational pathways:

- MSc / Pg. Dip / Pg Cert Advanced RT and Oncology Practice
- MSc Advanced Practice
- Pg Cert Pre-treatment

A placement in pre-treatment and supervision by a suitably -qualified radiotherapy health professional are necessary to fulfil the clinical practice requirement of the module.

Course aim

The aim of the course is to enable you to develop the necessary knowledge, understanding, clinical and evaluative skills required for the competent performance of independent breast localisation.

Content

This module is designed around a work-based learning model, whereby you will learn breast localisation skills during a programme of supervised clinical practice. Clinical learning will be supported by independent study of a range of on-line learning materials so that you can develop clinical reasoning and justification skills and be able to reflect on and evaluate your practice with reference to relevant evidence related to radiotherapy breast localisation.

Assessment

100% coursework, submitted on-line. Typically, a written critically reflective commentary and a portfolio of evidence.

Who teaches this course?

This is a work-based learning module that requires clinical supervision in the workplace. Experiential learning is supplemented by on-line electronic resources, activities and tasks. You are closely supported by the academic module leader who guides you through your learner journey.
